Search Tips

The Search box that appears near the top of the page on a SharePoint site for submitting queries. Here are some handy techniques for using the Search box. When entering your search terms, click the Magnifying icon located at the end of the search box.

- **Select a site to search:**
If it is displayed, use the list of sites (scopes) beside the Search box to narrow the range of your search. Narrowing the scope of a search lets you find sources for the information that you need. Instead of searching on All Sites, try a more specific scope such as This Site or This Site Only.
- **Type all the words to find all the words:**
When you type words in the Search box, your search returns content from the chosen scope that contains all of the words that you typed, in any order. For example, to find both words "district" and "office," type district office.
- **Enclose exact phrases in quotation marks**
To find a specific phrase, enclose it in quotation marks (""). For example, to find items that contain Alaska Fire Service, type "Alaska Fire Service" in the Search box. Your search returns content within the chosen scope that contains the exact phrase.
- **Exclude certain search results:**
To exclude search results that contain certain terms, use a minus sign (-) before the term that you want to exclude. For example, if you want to find items that contain the word "district" but do not include the word "office," type district -office in the Search box.
- **Try "Did you mean?" suggestions:**
The search results page displays a Did you mean? feature above the search results. This feature suggests alternate queries that you can try. Each suggestion is formatted as a link. To search again on an alternate query, just click the link.
